



<u>Du'aa is worship</u>


And your Lord said: "Invoke Me, [i.e. believe in My Oneness (Islâmic Monotheism)] (and ask Me for anything) I will respond to your (invocation). Verily! Those who scorn My worship [i.e. do not invoke Me, and do not believe in My Oneness, (Islâmic Monotheism)] they will surely enter Hell in humiliation!"

Surah Ghafir 40:60

Allah may give you what you ask for.

10 MANNERS OF MAKING DU'AA

"And your Lord said: 'Supplicate to Me and I will respond to you."

Surah Ghafir 40:60

There are many different manners of making du'aa that we know from the Qur'an and the Sunnah of our Messenger . Here are 10 for you to learn and try to put into practice!





FACE QIBLAH

The Prophet () faced the Ka`ba and invoked evil on some people of Quraish, on Shaiba bin Rabi`a, `Utba bin Rabi`a, Al-Walid bin `Utba and Abu Jahl bin Hisham...(Al-Bukhari 3690)

Muslims face the Ka'bah when they make du'aa following the sunnah of the Messenger ...


There are several narrations that describe the Prophet turning to face the the Qiblah when making duaa.

In a hadith related by Muslim (1763), the Prophet faced the Qiblah on the day of Badr and called out 'O Allah,carry out for me that which You promised me...'

RAISE YOUR HANDS

In the same hadith (Muslim 1763), the Prophet 'extended his hands' while making du'aa.





MAKE DUAA IN SECRET

Invoke your Lord with humility and in secret.

Surah Al-Araf 7:55

Making du'aa in secret helps with your sincerity. You are making du'aa for Allah alone and are not concerned with anyone hearing you.

Allah praised the prophet Zakariya when he mentioned his du'aa in the Qur'an.



When he called out his Lord (Allâh) a call in secret.

Surah Maryam 19:3



MAKE HEART-FELT DU'AA

And invoke Him with fear and hope

Surah Al-Araf 7:56



Narrated Abu Hurairah:

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Call upon Allah while being certain of being answered, and know that Allah does not respond to a supplication from a heart that is inattentive and heedless." (At-Tirmidhee 3479)

When you make du'aa with your heart that is present and paying attention, it is more likely to be answered.

For example your heart should feel hope, fear, humility among other emotions when making duaa. 5.

ASK WITH DETERMINATION

Allah's Messenger () said, "Whenever anyone of you invoke Allah for something, he should be firm in his asking, and he should not say: 'If You wish, give me...' for none can compel Allah to do something against His Will." (Bukhari 7464)

When you are determined in your du'aa it shows that you place your trust in Allah and know that Allah is able to answer your duaa.

PRAISE ALLAH FIRST

"Fadalah bin `Ubaid narrated: While the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) was seated, a man entered and performed Salat, and he said: 'O Allah, forgive me, and have mercy upon me.' The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: 'You have rushed, Oh praying person. When you perform Salat and then sit, then praise Allah with what He is deserving of, and send Salat upon me, then call upon Him." He said: "Then another man performed Salat after that, so he praised Allah and sent Salat upon the Prophet (ﷺ). The Prophet (ﷺ) said to him: 'O praying person! Supplicate, and you shall be answered."(Jami` at-Tirmidhi 3476, Al-Albani said 'saheeh.')

So the Messenger advised to praise Allah first.



THEN SEND PRAYERS ON THE MESSENGER

The above hadith informs us that we should also send salat upon the Prophet ﷺ after praising Allah.

USE DUAA FROM THE QURAN AND SUNNAH

The Qur'an is Allah's speech and the hadith are also revelation which Allah blessed the Messenger with.


They include many du'aa that in a few words include lots of good meanings.

For Example:

"Our Lord! Give us in this world that which is good and in the Hereafter that which is good, and save us from the torment of the Fire!" Surah Bagarah 2:201

MAKE DUAA FOR YOUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN ISLAM



It is recommended to make du'aa for your brothers and sisters in Islam when they are not present.

We know this from a hadith of the Messenger which mentions a special reward.

Abu Dardaa said that he heard the Prophet say "There is no Muslim servant who supplicates for his brother in the absence of presence, except that the Angel says: 'and for you be the like." (Muslim 6864)

You can make duaa for all of the believers like the duaa of the Prophet Ibraheem.

Our Lord, forgive me and my parents and the believers on the Day when the reckoning will be established. Surah Ibraheem 14:41

END YOUR DU'AA BY MENTIONING A QUALITY OF ALLAH

There are examples in the Qur'an of du'aa where Allah's beautiful names and characteristics are mentioned at the end of du'aa. They match what the person is making du'aa for. For example:

"Our Lord! Grant us what You promised unto us through Your Messengers and disgrace us not on the Day of Resurrection, for You never break (Your) Promise."

Surah Al-E-Imran 3:194

Because the believers are asking their Lord to give them what He has promised, they describe Him as always being true to His promises.

In the last third of the night. (Bukhari 1145)



In sujood. (Muslim 482)



Between the Athan and the Iqama. (At-Tirmidhee 212 Sahih Al-Albani)

When a fasting person is fasting. (Ibn Majah 1752 Sahih -Al-Albani)



When someone wrongs you. (Bukhari 1496)



The Day of Arafah. (Muslim 1348)




MANNERS OF MAKING DU'AA






