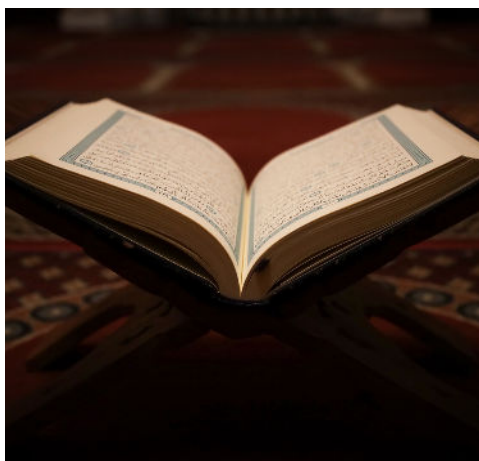


Shaykh Rabee' ibn Haadee Al-Madkhalee

Early Life

Shaykh Rabee was born in 1351 AH in a small village called Jiradiyah. The village has now merged into the city of Samitah which is located in Southern Saudi Arabia. His father died when he was just one and half years old.



His mother took excellent care of him and encouraged him to be truthful and trustworthy. When he was just 8 years old he joined circles of knowledge in his village. He learnt how to read, write and memorise Qur'an.

Shaykh Rabee' studied in the Islamic University of Al-Madīnah An-Nabawīyyah, for four years before graduating in the year 1384AH with the grade: Mumtāz (Excellent).

He continued his studies in Makkah and then returned to Madinah to teach hadith at the University. He later became a professor there.

A great advisor

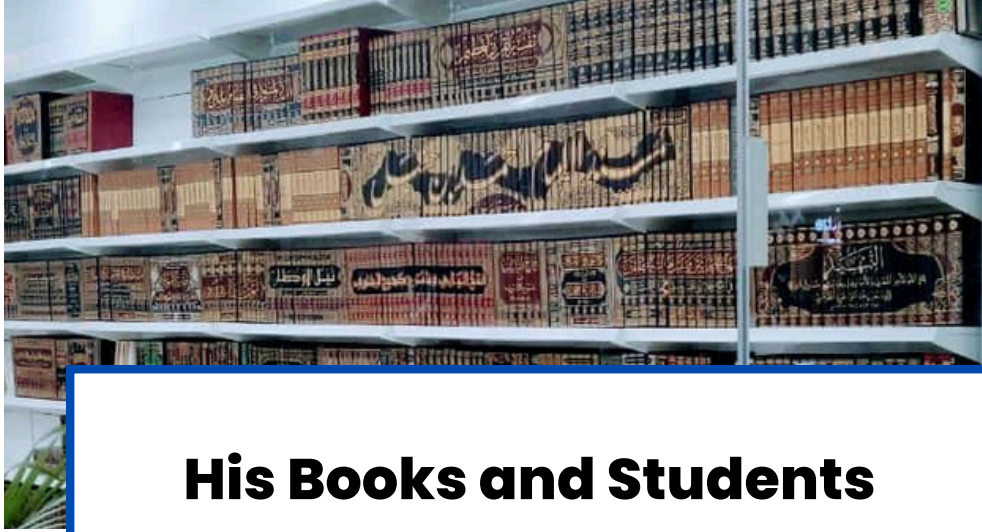
He gave good advice to those around him. He advised them with lovely manners.

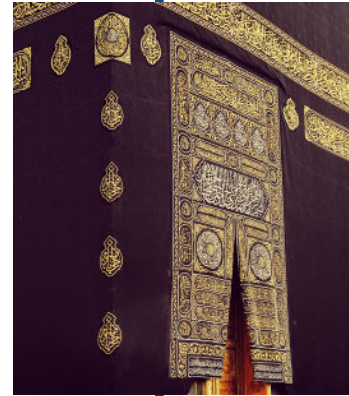

Our Shaykh returned to his Lord on the 14th Muharram 1447 AH. He died and was buried in Madinah, May Allah have mercy upon him.

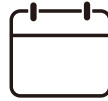
